4. Trim drape to cover foam dressing with additional 3-5 cm border of int	act skin.	
5. Remove stabilization layers (#2) as you apply drape. Remove blue hand	lling tabs.	
6. Choose pad application site. Pinch drape & cut 2.5 cm (quarter sized) h	ole through the drape.	Do not
